Trip Itinerary is as follows: (Itinerary may change due to booking availability.)

Day One	Brisbane to Alice Springs
Depart Brisbane around in the morning and arrive at Alice Springs around lunch time. Time to	
Day Two.	Alice Springs to Uluru (Lunch / Dinner)
We pick you up outside your accommodation at 5.45am and drive through the beautiful outback to Uluru, viewing Mount Connor on the way. First stop at Uluru is the Cultural Centre for an insight into the unique culture of the local Aboriginal people, followed by a healthy lunch. We do a guided Mutijulu Waterhole walk and learn the history of amazing Uluru. Then you are free to do the 9km base walk, or if you wish, climb Uluru (unguided). Later we watch a spectacular Uluru sunset and sip sparkling wine. Then on to our campsite for hot showers, a hearty meal and a night sleeping in a swag under millions of outback stars. (Lunch, Dinner included)	
Day Three: -	Uluru, Kata Tjuta, Kings Creek Cattle Station (Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner)
Up early for a spectacular Uluru sunrise and healthy breakfast. We then head to Kata Tjuta (The Olgas) for a guided 5.5km walk through the Valley of the Winds, followed by lunch. Next we drive to Kings Creek Station to relax and enjoy an outback BBQ. Tonight, after a hot shower, we will be sleeping in a safari tent. (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner included)	
Day Four: -	Kings Canyon to Alice Springs (Breakfast / Lunch)
After breakfast, we drive to Kings Canyon for a guided 6km Canyon Rim Walk in one of the most spectacular areas of the outback. Visit the natural Amphitheatre, North and South Walls, and the exotic Garden of Eden along the way. After lunch we return to Alice Springs stopping at Mount Ebenezer Roadhouse, arriving back to Alice Springs early evening. (Optional camel ride is available at your own expense)
